Inflatable Water Park Rules

- Life jackets (PFD3) must be worn at all times
- Wrist bands must be worn at all times
- No head first diving or flipping from equipment
- Minimum age requirement of 6
- Children under 6 must be accompanied by an adult.
- No climbing on equipment directly behind or below other patrons.
- No jumping or sliding from equipment when other patrons are below.
- No jewellery or sharp objects allowed on equipment.
- No smoking, eating or drinking on equipment.
- No pushing
- No diving under equipment
- No pulling or tampering or ropes or rings... Keep clear.
- Patrons must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- No rudeness or disobedience to Staff Attendants - zero tolerance - one strike and you are out.
- Entry on to Aqua Park equipment is not permitted if staff are not present.
- No swimming allowed for non - paying patrons in lagoon area for own safety.
