

## Food Licence Certificate

### Food Act 2006

Sunshine Coast Council hereby on 29 August 2018 renews a Licence to carry on a licensable food business in accordance with the *Food Act 2006*:

#### Licence conditions

The Licensee must:

1. Comply with the *Food Act 2006*
2. Comply with the *Food Safety Standards 3.2.3 (Food Standards Code)*
3. Display the licence in a prominent position at the premises so it is easily visible to persons at the premises
4. Allow an authorised person to have reasonable access to the licensee's premises under the licence during normal business hours for the food business
5. Comply with the *Food Safety Standards 3.2.2 (Food Standards Code)*
6. Notify council of proposed alterations or additions to the approved operations or fit-out before proceeding
7. Not permit dogs other than assistance animals as defined under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* to be present in an outdoor dining area unless all of the following criteria are met:-
  - a) It is used for dining, drinking or both drinking and dining
  - b) It is not used for the preparation of food
  - c) It is not an *enclosed area*\*
  - d) It can be entered by the public without passing through an *enclosed area*\*

\***enclosed area** means an area that, except for doorways and passageways, is substantially or completely closed, whether permanently or temporarily, by :- (a) A ceiling or roof; and (b) walls or windows or both walls and windows.

**Note:** it is considered that an outdoor dining area with a roof and plastic sheeting which can be rolled down dependant on the weather meets the definition of an *enclosed area*\* and therefore cannot be considered an outdoor dining area. Dogs are therefore not allowed.

The issue of this licence in no way implies that all or any other approvals under any other legislation have been obtained or conditions complied with.

Any other approvals required under any other legislation must be obtained before commencement of the proposed use.
